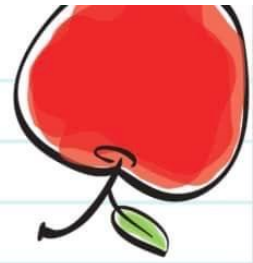
AS OUR NEW MATH COACH!

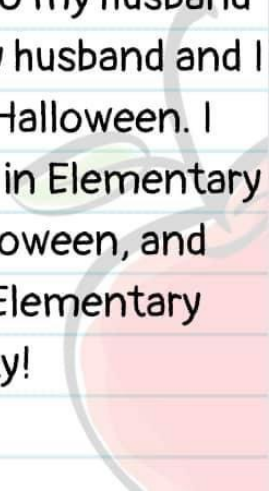

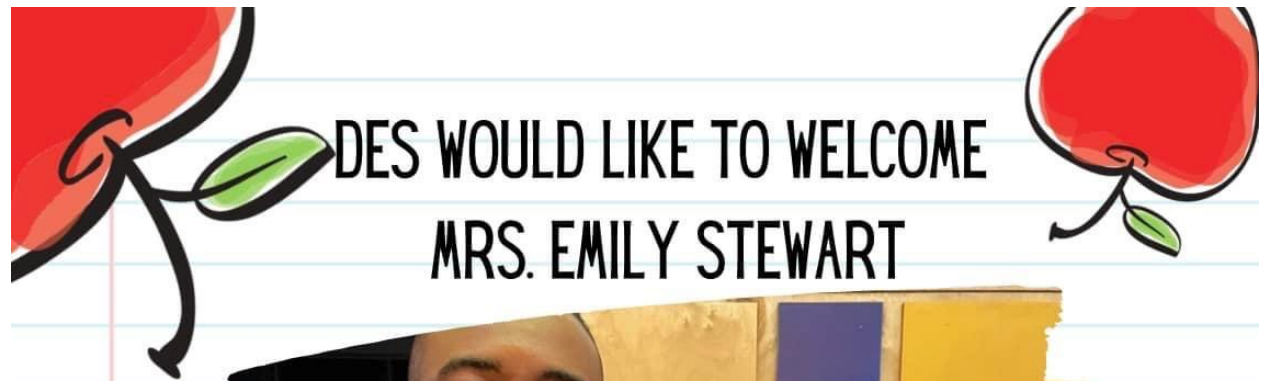
TO THE KINDERGARTEN TEAM



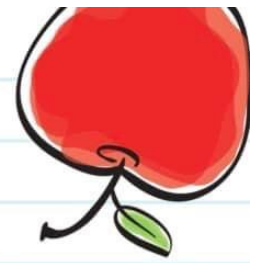

TO THE 2ND GRADE TEAM




My name is Emily Stewart and I am so excited to teach 2nd grade at Dadeville this upcoming school year!
